TASTING NOTES

This Cabernet opens with rich toasted oak, mocha, toasted bread, and a slight hint of road tar, which leads to notes of black cherry, black currant, black berry and a touch of anise, vanilla and allspice. Big rich mouthfeel, and very concentrated, making for a very serious wine.
