TASTING NOTES

Showing beautiful transparency in a brick colored blend, scents of raspberry and strawberry open to warm toasted oak, and vanilla. Medium in body, this fruit forward wine gives a fresh mouthfeel while still showing off silkiness. Plum and boysenberry come forward, offset by light mocha and vanilla.
