### **WINEMAKING NOTES:**

The grapes were selected from several vineyards across the Columbia Valley, providing a range of different characteristics which create greater nuance and complexity when blended together.

## **TASTING NOTES:**

**AROMA/FLAVOR:** Very nice elements of black currant, black cherry, black berry, with subtle toasty notes of dark roasted coffee bean, vanilla, and baking spice. Soft, rich, and very approachable.

VARIETALS: 84% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot, 1% Malbec

**ALCOHOL:** 14% **TA(gal/L):** 5.1 **VA(gal/L):** 0.56 **PH:** 3.78

**AGING:** Aged 28 months - 40% was barrel aged in 3rd and 4th fill American oak barrels, 60% was aged in stainless steel.
