



TASTING NOTES

Fresh dark fruits like blackberry and black cherry are prominent on the nose, complemented by prominent flavors of nutmeg and baking spices, with a subtle hint of mocha. The mouthfeel is big and concentrated, fully supported by the wine's tannin and acid structure. Pair it with a grilled tomahawk ribeye.
