TASTING NOTES

A blend of Bordeaux varieties, and true to Sentinel style, this vintage is dry and full-bodied, layered with black currant, black cherry, and toasted oak notes. The initial impression on the palate is intense, with a concentrated body, rich tannin structure, and powerful finishing notes of dark chocolate, roasted coffee beans, anise, and vibrant black cherry flavors.
