This wine displays a rich concentration of plum and dark roasted coffee, dark chocolate, and nutmeg. Fresh fig jam from the nose to the finish. Subtle allspice with bright black berry overtones complete an earthy closing. Pair with rack of lamb, hamburgers, or loaded veggie nachos.

Ryan Patrick is known for its Naked Chardonnay, Redhead Red and Rock Island Red labels, and for its Reserve wines. Most Recently, Wine Critic James Suckling awarded 93 points to the 2017 Ryan Patrick Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon.
