### TASTING NOTES

Our Crescent Cuvée, named after the hidden recreational treasure, Crescent Bar, is a Rhone-style white blend using varietals that are rare to the Columbia Valley. This wine swirls into aromas of stone fruits, lemon grass and herbal tea. The palate is smooth with pear and honey flavors, and a touch of spice gives this "hidden gem" some presence.

From its beginnings as a family winery named after its grape-growing family founders' two sons, to today's incarnation as a Columbia Valley AVA star with a Leavenworth landmark tasting room, Ryan Patrick will continue to make approachable wines with a serious edge. Batch-tinkering approaches have resulted in varietals and blends that have justifiably become famous for how they out-perform their price point.

Ryan Patrick is known for its Naked Chardonnay, Redhead Red and Rock Island Red labels, and for its Reserve wines. Most Recently, Wine Critic James Suckling awarded 93 points to the 2017 Ryan Patrick Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon.
