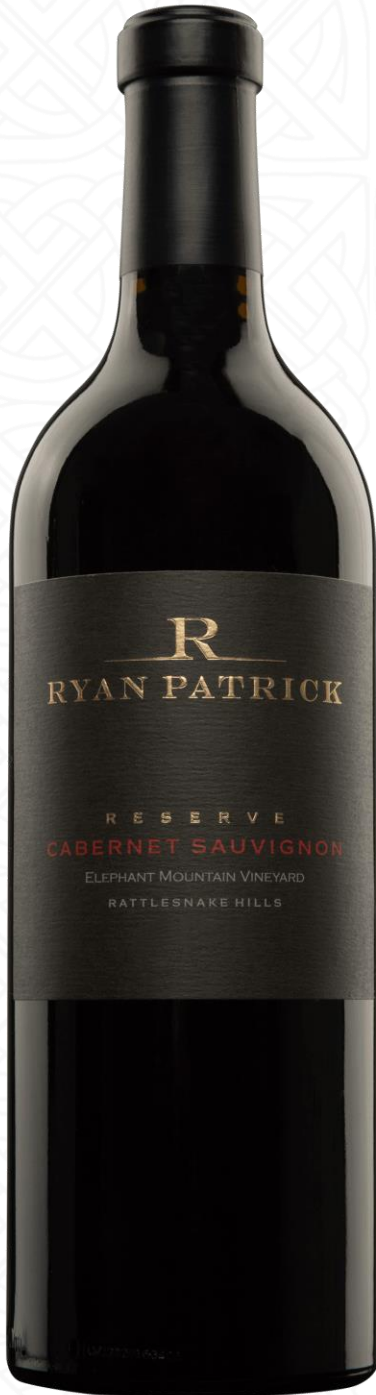

Aromatics of black currants, tobacco, and cherry are up front. Structured on the palate with rich fruit tannins and a long oak finish.

Ryan Patrick is known for its Naked Chardonnay, Redhead Red and Rock Island Red labels, and for its Reserve wines. Most Recently, Wine Critic James Suckling awarded 93 points to the 2017 Ryan Patrick Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon.
