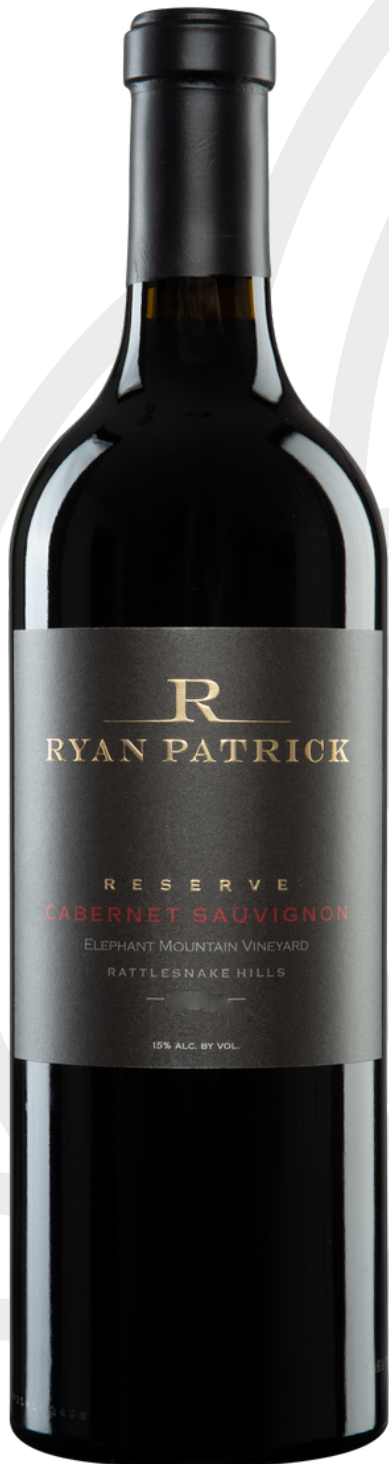

From its beginnings as a family winery named after its grape-growing family founders' two sons, to today's incarnation as a Columbia Valley AVA star with a Leavenworth landmark tasting room, Ryan Patrick will continue to make approachable wines with a serious edge. Batch-tinkering approaches have resulted in varietals and blends that have justifiably become famous for how they out-perform their price point.

Ryan Patrick is known for its Naked Chardonnay, Redhead Red and Rock Island Red labels, and for its Reserve wines.
