Hints of creamy caramel apple, ripe pear and traces of pineapple. A viscous entry with a rich full mid palate and a long pleasing finish. Pair with white fish tacos and mango salsa!

Ryan Patrick is known for its Naked Chardonnay, Redhead Red and Rock Island Red labels, and for its Reserve wines.
