Smooth, approachable cabernet sauvignon. Fruit forward, with notes of blackberry, cocoa, and coffee perfectly balanced for the most splendid glass of wine.

Blend – 80% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot
Vineyards – Wahluke Slope, Ravenscliff, Newhouse
Aging - 5% barrel aged in neutral American oak barrels for 44 months, 95% SS aged

From its beginnings as a family winery named after its grape-growing family founders' two sons, to today's incarnation as a Columbia Valley AVA star with a Leavenworth landmark tasting room, Ryan Patrick will continue to make approachable wines with a serious edge. Batch-tinkering approaches have resulted in varietals and blends that have justifiably become famous for how they out-perform their price point.

Ryan Patrick is known for its Naked Chardonnay, Redhead Red and Rock Island Red labels, and for its Reserve wines.
