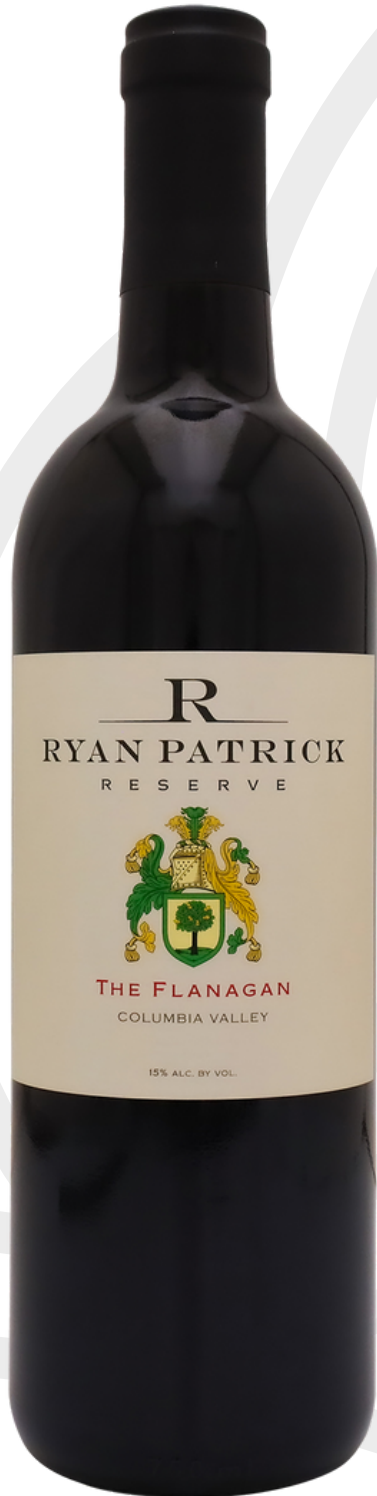

TASTING NOTES

This wine is homage to the Flanagans, the founding family of Ryan Patrick Wines and their Irish roots that run deep. This Cabernet Franc is a strong and glorious wine that will conquer your senses. Grapes for this wine were selected from the renowned Wahluke Slope AVA of Washington State.

Baked plum and cherry on the nose. On the palate, hints of white pepper, coffee, allspice, and red fruits. A strong presence of tannin, with a mouthwatering finish.

Blend: Cabernet Franc 86%, Cab Sauv 7%, Malbec 7%
Vineyards: Clifton Vyd, Ravenscliff, Elephant Mtn
Aging: 100% barrel aged, 2nd & 3rd fill barrels. American oak.

From its beginnings as a family winery named after its grape-growing family founders' two sons, to today's incarnation as a Columbia Valley AVA star with a Leavenworth landmark tasting room, Ryan Patrick will continue to make approachable wines with a serious edge. Batch-tinkering approaches have resulted in varietals and blends that have justifiably become famous for how they out-perform their price point.

Ryan Patrick is known for its Naked Chardonnay, Redhead Red and Rock Island Red labels, and for its Reserve wines.

Most Recently, Wine Critic James Suckling awarded 93 points to the 2017 Ryan Patrick Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon.
