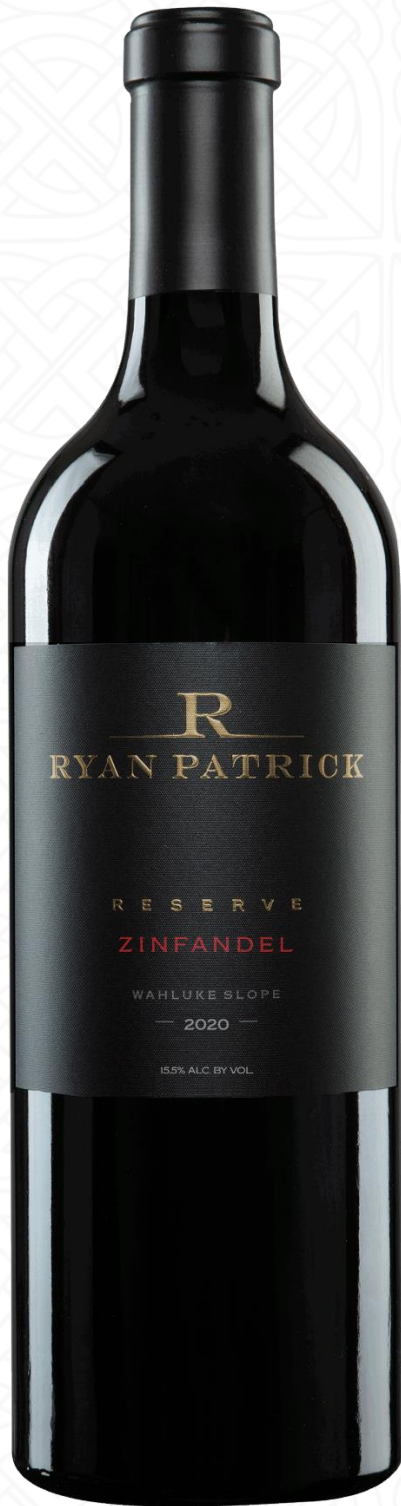

TASTING NOTES

A lift of subtle vanilla, and spice notes on the nose leads to a pinwheel of ripe dates and roasted plums with black berries, and pomegranate. A classic fruit-forward Zinfandel. Pair with veal or creamy rigatoni.

Ryan Patrick is known for its Naked Chardonnay, Redhead Red and Rock Island Red labels, and for its Reserve wines. Most Recently, Wine Critic James Suckling awarded 93 points to the 2017 Ryan Patrick Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon.
